Endorsement criteria

JUDICIAL

- Substantial experience in and demonstrated understanding of civil litigation and issues recurrent in defense of claims;
- •A willingness to fairly and even-handedly apply the law as written, including the Rules of Evidence, the Rules of Civil Procedure, the application of affirmative defenses, and the granting of dispositive motions when warranted;
- •A recognition of the legislature's role in changing existing common laws and statutes and the Court's role in interpreting existing common law and statutes in a fair, consistent and predictable manner;
- Judicial temperament.

LEGISLATIVE

- •A demonstrated understanding of the value of businesses and industry to the citizens of North Carolina as employers, vendors, risk managers and contributors of tax revenue;
- •A demonstrated commitment to the fair allocation of risks and responsibilities among consumers, businesses and industry in order to promote an efficient marketplace for all.
